What is Ag-Ed?

- An agricultural education experience for children in years 5 & 6
- Younger grades are always welcome to attend. These grades are the responsibility of the Teachers and carers.
- It involves students attending interactive agricultural sessions with industry representatives, experts and Primary Producers.
- Ag-Ed supports the classroom teacher through the provision of a Teacher Resource Package containing information and student activities representing a variety of agricultural industries, if requested.



Why Ag-Ed?

- The aim of Ag-Ed is to provide both city and country children with knowledge and understanding of the impact and relevance the agricultural industry has on their everyday lives.
- It provides children with a "classroom without walls" experience
 of the paddock to product processes of a variety of industries,
 as well as the sustainability issues that support them.
- Experiencing Ag-Ed enables children to appreciate the codependence of urban and rural communities.



When does Ag-Ed happen?

In order to ensure a covid safe event, Ag-Ed will take place on **Thursday 5th September 2024**, the day before the Beaudesert Show and will run from 10:00 am - 1:30 pm.
