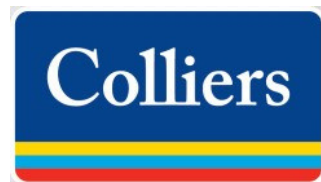

BEAUDESERT SHOW SOCIETY CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

Applicable to all sections – See also By-Laws

1. The STEWARDS of each section SHALL settle any DISPUTE arising therein; however the EXHIBITOR has the privilege of lodging a WRITTEN PROTEST against any decision thus given (BY-LAW 7) which will be dealt with by the committee whose ruling is final.
2. Should an EXHIBITOR desire to impart any information regarding an EXHIBIT to the JUDGE such information shall be imparted ONLY THROUGH THE MEDIUM OF THE OFFICIATING HONORARY STEWARD, AND SOLEY AT HIS/HER DISCRETION. Should any EXHIBITOR infringe this regulation; HIS OR HER EXHIBIT SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY DISQUALIFIED.

PRIVILEGES OF MEMBERS

1. Admission to grounds on both days of the Show.
2. Eligibility for nomination to the Management Committee of our Society.
3. Members may leave the grounds at ANY TIME during the Show and be readmitted on inspection of their Member's Wrist Band. Member's Wrist Bands are not transferable.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

- Membership fees inclusive of GST.
- Membership Fees are due on the 1st November each year for the succeeding 12 months. Applications for new Membership close on the 30th June 2024.

NOTES FOR EXHIBITORS

- ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES, AND WILL BE AS STATED THROUGHOUT THE SCHEDULE.
- STOCK EXHIBITORS are reminded that they must give names of all exhibits to ensure correct allocation of catalogue numbers. If for any reason this is impossible - exhibitors must indicate in which classes, the same animal is competing. In classes requiring TB free or Brucellosis free animals the exhibitor MUST PRODUCE A CERTIFICATE BEFORE CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES
- THE BY-LAWS AND REGULATIONS comprised in the model uniform Schedule compiled by the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies (*except where such may be modified or added to by Beaudesert Show Society By-Laws or Special Regulations comprised herein. Such By-Laws and Special Regulations can be found in the back of the Show Schedule*) SHALL be the CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION, and ALL exhibitors and competitors shall make their entries or enter into the competition on this expressed condition. The BOUNDARIES of the Scenic Rim Council and/or the area previously known as Beaudesert Shire (This being the southern side of School Road, Logan Reserve; Koplick Road; Old Greenbank Road and Teviot Road) shall apply to all "LOCAL EVENTS" in this Schedule unless otherwise specified and only entries from within these boundaries are eligible to compete in "LOCAL" Classes.

- NORCO WORK HORSE CHALLENGE - \$45.00 ENTRIES OPEN MONDAY 14th August 2024 Max 35 riders. PLEASE READ TERMS & CONDITIONS CAREFULLY.

- 1st \$10, 2nd \$5, 3rd \$2 (unless otherwise stated)

SHOW JUMPING - ENTRY ON THE DAY ONLY - please check each class for entry fees & prize money

ALL COMPETITORS must complete a horse health declaration upon nomination
ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE WEARING GATE ENTRY WRISTBANDS TO COMPETE. Wristbands must be worn at all times. Any wristband found damaged will result in them being deemed not valid.

REGULATIONS:

- **MAIDEN** - is a Pony, Galloway or Hack that has not won a first prize at any show.
- **NOVICE** - is a Pony Galloway or Hack that has not won an open championship at any show.
- **STALLIONS** - For Health & Safety reasons, **STALLIONS** must be suitably restrained at all times. **Riders and handlers of stallions to be 18 years and over.**

DRESS REQUIREMENTS:

- All riders and attendants must be neatly and appropriately attired whilst in the main area and/or judging ring. The Chief Steward has the right to exclude anyone from competing whose attire is inappropriate.

FRIDAY LOCAL DAY EVENTS:

- LOCAL EVENTS are confined to residency within the boundary of the Scenic Rim Regional Council and/or the area previously known as Beaudesert Shire (This being the southern side of School Road, Logan Reserve; Koplick Road; Old Greenbank Road and Teviot Road). To be eligible for a "Local" event: Entries must have been owned by a resident of the Scenic Rim Regional Council and/or the areas previously known as Beaudesert Shire (This being the southern side of School Road, Logan Reserve; Koplick Road; Old Greenbank Road and Teviot Road) three months prior to the date of the Show; for all other riders and horses in "Local" events, residency in the Scenic Rim Regional Council and/or the area previously known as Beaudesert Shire (This being the southern side of School Road, Logan Reserve; Koplick Road; Old Greenbank Road and Teviot Road) for three months prior to date of Show

SATURDAY ONLY - HACK CLASSES:

- On achieving an Open Saddle (ridden) Championship in one ring, your horse/pony is not eligible to compete in any further saddle (ridden) classes on the day apart from the Supreme Champion Hack of the show to be held Saturday afternoon at the completion of all events.
- JUMPING ENTRIES will be accepted by the Steward in the ring on the day. NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED
- OTHER HORSE ENTRIES will be accepted at the Ringside Entry Offices up to 30 minutes prior to the time for each event. The receipted Entry Card will be handed to the Judges Steward prior to judging.
- ENTRIES can only be entered in classes for Stallions, Jumping and Stockhorse events and the Stockman's Turnout. Led Stallions must wear a bit or chain.
- **JUDGING will not be held up awaiting competitors occupied in other events programmed for the same time. A choice between such events must be made by the competitor.**
- **DISPUTES arising from any entry questioned or on any matter not provided for in the Rules of the Society will be referred to a Disputes Committee (comprising the Chief Ring Steward and two Committee Members) who will adjudicate thereon.**
- **TIMES stated are approximate only. Events will not start earlier than the times indicated in the Schedule. No refunds unless authorised by Chief Steward.**
- **STABLES** are provided free of charge, but cannot be booked in advance.
- AGE of competitor (where age is a condition of eligibility) will be taken at the first day of the Show.

- **Friday Program:** RIDERS in Pony Hack Classes shall be under 17 years of age. **Saturday Program:** Adults can ride ponies unless otherwise stated.
- **PONIES** - Height not to exceed 14 hands
- **GALLOWAYS** - Height over 14 hands and not exceeding 15 hands
- **HACKS** - Over 15 hands
- **GALLOWAYS** may not compete in both Galloway and Hack Classes.
- **OWNERS AND COMPETITORS** are responsible for the proper supervision of all exhibits at all times whilst on the Showgrounds.
- **OWNERS AND COMPETITORS** shall be held responsible for all damage caused by them or their exhibits whilst on the Showgrounds.
- **THE USE OF TRANQUILLIZERS AND/OR OTHER DRUGS IS PROHIBITED.** Any OWNER AND/OR EXHIBITOR violating this rule will be dealt with by the Society. The Society may make or cause to be made any test of any Exhibit to determine whether any drug or stimulant has been administered to such an exhibit and may take possession of any such exhibit for any of the aforesaid purposes and detain such horse for such period as is deemed necessary.
- **COMPETITORS** are advised to read the SPECIAL REGULATIONS and BY-LAWS of the Society printed at the back of the Schedule.
- **BREED CLASSES** (where age is a condition of eligibility) will take the 1st August of the year of the Show to calculate age. Age horses must be registered with their respective Breed Associations.
- UNLESS THERE ARE 4 OR MORE ENTRIES IN A RIDDEN CLASS - entries may be combined
- ANY NOMINATED BREED THAT HAS NO COMPETITORS THIS YEAR may be discontinued
- **HELMETS & FOOTWEAR** - All riders are required to wear approved safety headwear and riding boots at all times

JUDGES:

- Judges must be suitably attired in either riding clothes, ladies, neat street attire, men, suit or sports coat and tie and hat whilst judging.
- A judge shall not send a substitute judge without the permission of the show society concerned.
- A judge shall be reported to the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies for failure to attend a show to which he or she is committed, or appear in time for the advertised commencement of the classes without reasonable cause.
- An exhibit is ineligible to compete if the competitor/exhibitor is a member of the judge's family.
- An exhibitor is ineligible to compete if the horse has been owned or leased by the judge, a member of his/her family, his or her employer or business partner within the last three months.
- An exhibitor is ineligible to compete if the competitor/exhibitor or his or her family has provided accommodation for the judge immediately prior to or during the show.
- An exhibitor is ineligible to compete if any part of the combination has been given tuition by the judge or his/her business partner within the last three months.
- An exhibitor is ineligible to compete, if the competitor/exhibitor has been employed by or has been partner of the judge, within the last three months.
- An exhibitor is ineligible to compete if the competitor/exhibitor has given tuition to the judge or trained a horse owned or leased by the judge within the last three months.
- A judge shall not visit the horse stables, nor the owner, nor inspect or discuss any horse entered in the show prior to or during the judging of the relevant section.
- **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS OTHER THAN SERVICE DOGS**

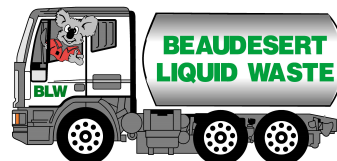

BY-LAWS

1. OPENING.

a. The gates will be open to the Public at 8 a.m. on Friday and Saturday, September 6th and 7th 2024.

2. ADMISSION

a. Charges for admission will be as follows:

Single Day passes are for either Friday or Saturday – are not transferable
Adult 1 Day Pass
Pensioner 1 Day (on production of card)
Student 12yrs + (on production of card)
Children 11yrs & under
Two Day Adult Pass
Two Day Student/Pension pass
Parking

b. Members are Free on production of their WRIST BAND which are NOT TRANSFERABLE.

c. Attendants Wrist Band will be issued ONLY WHERE NECESSARY - three wrist bands is the maximum that will be issued to any one exhibitor and only where exhibits need three attendants. A Member's Ticket counts as a pass.

d. The above rates and conditions of admission are subject to alteration at any time before the Show.

3. BAD WEATHER POLICY

a. Beau Desert Show is an outdoor event. The show society is not liable to give a refund or exchange the pass for cancellation of any reason. The operation of some attractions may be affected by adverse weather conditions or maintenance activity. If rain or bad weather occurs, the show will proceed, unless demanded unsafe or unable to continue with featured events.

b. There will be no refunds due to poor weather conditions or cancelled events.

4. CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

a. The BY-LAWS are the REGULATIONS and SPECIAL REGULATIONS are also to be Conditions of Competition.

b. ALL EXHIBITS MUST be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor for ONE MONTH before the exhibition. All Farm and Horticultural Produce MUST be the production of the person exhibiting it, and all livestock exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor on the date entries close (unless otherwise stated) as listed in the Schedule.

c. Exhibits entered in the wrong class may be transferred to the appropriate class by the Stewards.

d. For ALL CLASSES in Horse and Cattle Sections in which the age of the exhibits or the competitor is a condition, the Entry Form shall state actual age which shall be attained at the date for Judging.

e. No exhibitor will be allowed to attach to his exhibits, or display in any manner, any medal, ribbon or distinguishing badges, unless they have been won at the PRESENT EXHIBITION.

f. Any Exhibitor REMOVING his exhibit from the grounds before the appointed time may be DISQUALIFIED from exhibiting at future exhibitions, and his Prize Money, if any, shall be FORFEITED.

g. HACKS can compete in all classes open to Hacks, Hunters, and Miscellaneous Horses, but a Heavyweight cannot compete as a Lightweight.

5. ENTRIES

- a. All entries shall be made on printed forms, to be obtained from the SECRETARY on application or on the website (www.beaudesertshow.org.au) and NO ENTRY will be valid unless signed by the Exhibitor or his Agent.
- b. ENTRIES MUST REACH THE SECRETARY before the date specified in the Schedule unless otherwise stated.
- c. Should any person make an entry for which there is not any Prize in the Prize Schedule, and should the exhibit be of special merit, the Society reserves the right of awarding a prize to such exhibit.
- d. ENTRY FEES MUST, IN ALL CASES, BE PAID WHEN MAKING THE ENTRY.
- e. THE COMMITTEE reserves the right to adjudicate on any questionable entry or any other point not provided for in the Rules of the Society, and of making any alteration that may be deemed necessary.
- f. THE DECISION of the COMMITTEE on all points shall be FINAL, without recourse.

6. EXHIBITS

- a. All Exhibits MUST be delivered to and removed from the exhibition at the cost and risk of the exhibitor.
- b. The Society will NOT, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss, damage to, or delivery of any exhibit unless otherwise stated. All exhibits MUST be collected by the time as listed in the schedule.
- c. Except where otherwise specified, all exhibits must be in their place as directed by the Steward at such times as advertised in the schedule for each section. This rule will be strictly adhered to.

7. DISEASE OR DANGER

- a. Should there be any reason to suspect that any exhibit is either diseased or dangerous, or objectionable the Committee reserves the right to remove same or refuse its admittance.
- b. Should any exhibit, having gained a Prize, be disqualified, the next on the list does NOT necessarily obtain the Prize. The Committee with or without the advice of the Judge shall decide the question.

8. PROTESTS

ALL PROTESTS MUST BE lodged with the Secretary, addressed to her, and accompanied by a DEPOSIT of \$50 within 1 HOUR of the notification of the Judge's Awards. If the protest is considered frivolous by the Committee the deposit may be FORFEITED. In the hearing of all protests and disputes arising out of an award, the Committee shall abide by the Judge's book unless it be shown that the Judges have been willfully or accidentally misled. THE DECISION OF THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE FINAL.

9. PRIZE AWARDS

The PRIZE AWARDS affixed to all exhibits shall be distinguished by the following colours:-

- RED, WHITE AND ROYAL BLUE, TRI-COLOUR FOR GRAND CHAMPION
- PURPLE FOR CHAMPION
- GREEN FOR RESERVE CHAMPION
- ROYAL BLUE FOR FIRST
- RED FOR SECOND
- WHITE FOR THIRD
- YELLOW FOR FOURTH
- PALE BLUE FOR FIFTH AND SIXTH

All prizes must be claimed before the last day of September 2024.

10. INFRINGEMENT OF BY-LAWS ETC.

- a. It shall be incumbent upon all exhibitors to make themselves thoroughly conversant with ALL THE BY-LAWS dealing with their EXHIBITS, for in NO case shall a plea of ignorance be accepted.
- b. In the case of an exhibitor infringing any of the By-Laws or regulations, it shall be in the power of the Committee, upon proof of the same, to PROHIBIT such exhibitor from exhibiting and competing at any of the Society's exhibitions in the future.

11. APPOINTMENT OF JUDGES AND STEWARDS

- a. The Committee will select Judges and Stewards for all Sections and fill up any subsequent vacancies.
- b. In ALL MATTERS of procedure the Stewards will act under the direction of the Committee.

12. JUDGING

- a. Judging in ALL SECTIONS will start at the times shown at the beginning of the Schedule.
- b. Judging will take place at the time and place selected by the Committee. Each Judge will be supplied with instructions which he/she MUST ADHERE TO as closely as practicable.

13. INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES

- a. The Judges shall award a Second Prize if the exhibit is not considered worthy of a First, and shall not award any prize if the Exhibit is not up to sufficient merit.
 - b. Where two Judges are acting and they are unable to agree, they shall call a referee and his decision shall be FINAL. If the Judges cannot agree in appointing a referee, the Committee shall be called upon to do so.
 - c. The Judge need not award any Prize to an exhibit, which in his opinion, does not comply with the conditions.
 - d. In the Judging of LIVESTOCK, all questions as to eligibility of an exhibit with reference to age or breed shall be decided by the Judge. They may defer Judging the Class until the Exhibitor has produced proof if considered necessary.
 - e. The Judges shall decide on the merit of each exhibit, without reference to the name or place of the exhibitor or breeder, and shall only take notice of the animal, its age and number. When judging by points they may be provided with the pedigree if required to complete their card.
 - f. The Secretary shall furnish the Judge with a Schedule of the Prizes, but such shall not contain any information as to the name or place of the owners of the exhibits.
 - g. In awarding Championships, First Prize winners in each Class only to compete, but the Judges will be required to select the next animal in order of merit, to be called the Reserve. Exhibits gaining Second Prize in the Class from which the Champion is selected to be led into the ring to compete for Reserve Champion.
- ### 14. APPLICATION FOR SPACE
- a. For the Exhibitor of all classes of manufacture, machinery etc., application for space MUST be made to the Secretary as early as possible. Such change as the Committee may determine shall be made for ground and wall space. The Committee may use discretionary powers as to space to be allotted to each exhibitor, and games of skill or chance, or any cheapjack's will not be permitted on the grounds.

b. The Committee reserves the right to have removed any item which in their opinion is considered dangerous or objectionable, and which is exhibited or offered to patrons as an item for sale or as a Prize given or distributed in any manner, and further reserves the right to immediately cancel space allocation for the current Show period and/or any further Shows held on these grounds.

c. THE SOCIETY reserves the right to reject any application for display space or the right to exhibit in its sole discretion and its decision in this regard shall be final.

d. All applications for space to be accompanied by a current CERTIFICATE OF CURRENCY of Public Liability Insurance Cover.

15. STEWARDS

a. SHALL attend at ALL times and places notified to them by the Secretary.

b. SHALL attend to the reception, classification, numbering and placing of ALL EXHIBITS and to ALL matters in connection therewith.

c. SHALL attend to the Judges, furnish them with award books, Prize Cards or Ribbons, and afford them in all information and attention necessary to the discharge of their duties.

d. SHALL sign the Award Book conjointly with the Judges, Prepare Prize Cards, and see these and the Ribbons properly fixed to the Prize Exhibit, and in the case of a dispute, shall certify to the correctness of the Identity of the Awards.

e. SHALL in cases they think advisable, reject an exhibit in any Section, and report immediately to the Committee.

f. SHALL see that NO person is allowed to interfere with or interrupt the Judges when judging, and shall see that any offender is PROMPTLY REMOVED.

g. The Committee reserves the right to alter or omit any Class in the Schedule.

h. The decision of the Committee on ALL POINTS shall be FINAL without recourse.

i. An exhibitor shall not compete in a section if the Exhibitor is a member of the Judges immediate family.

16. COMMISSION ON STALLS

ALL EXHIBITS sold at exhibition or prior to their return to the owner's residence will be subject to a COMMISSION as arranged prior to the sale if sold by auction or private contract, calculated on the gross amount of the sale. Exhibitors will kindly NOTE that ALL EXHIBITS, unless otherwise stated, of livestock, fruit and vegetables MUST be in the grounds at the time stated in the Section.

WORKPLACE, HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT

Any Exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showground will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of all Exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Workplace Health and Safety Act of 2011. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of noncompliance with its provisions.

Any Exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Beaudesert Showground. Exhibitors should check all electrical equipment and leads before coming to the Showground to avoid the occurrence of any difficulties.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO BEAUDESERT SHOWGROUND

a. Wristbands must be worn at all times during the show.

b. Beaudesert Showground is a designated "GLASS FREE" area and no glass drink containers are permitted.

c. No liquor is to be brought onto the showground.

d. The Beaudesert Show Society reserves the right to inspect containers being brought onto the showground suspected of containing liquor.

e. Liquor must only be consumed in designated licensed areas.

f. No liquor to be consumed or carried in sideshow area.

g. Drunken, unruly, abusive, or offensive behaviour or fighting will result in removal from the showground.

h. Anyone providing alcohol to a person less than 18 years of age will be removed from the showground.

i. All directions given by authorised staff or security officers must be complied with forthwith.

j. Any person directed to leave the showground as a result of a breach of these regulations is forthwith barred from the showground, and any re-entry prior to the committee lifting such barring, will be deemed as trespassing and police will be called.

k. Any person already under the influence of alcohol will be refused entry to the showground.

l. The speed limit for vehicle on the showground is 10kph. Any form of reckless driving is prohibited.

m. Juveniles under the age of 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

n. All persons by entering the showground agree to abide by these regulations.
