- The Show Society will not be responsible for exhibits not collected
- MAXIMUM OF TWO ENTRIES PER PERSON PER CLASS
- All work must be the work of the exhibitor and must not have won a prize at any previous show of this Society
- Exhibits cannot be entered for, nor compete in more than one class
- If an item is entered in the incorrect class, Stewards will re-class it
- Definition of ANY OTHER ARTICLE NOT MENTIONED - if the item is specified in another Class, additional items cannot be entered
- In all classes the Judge will take into account the QUALITY of the work in making awards, which may result in NO 1st Prize being awarded
- Where classes feature a particular technique, the article must be predominately of that technique. i.e. patchwork, appliqué, etc
- All Exhibits must have been completed within the last 2 years
- Due to space restrictions, it is possible that not all entries can be displayed in full
