SPECIAL REGULATIONS

- All cattle entered in the Stud Beef Cattle Section, must be entered or eligible for entry in the Approved Herd Book
- All Bulls 1 year and over must be led with a nose ring lead
- All winners must appear in the Grand Parade, otherwise Ribbons and Prize Money may be withheld

- Grand Champion Ribbons will be awarded only when competition is such that both Junior and Senior Champion Ribbons have been awarded. In circumstances where one of either a Junior or Senior Champion has been awarded, that Stud beast will be eligible for competition at inter breed level
- Age to be determined as at 1st September of the year of the show

Stud Beef Truck Parking and unloading of Stock: UNLOADING OF STOCK - All stock must be unloaded on the western side of the stud beef shed and ring. A loading ramp will be made available in this location for use for Stud Beef Competitors.
